(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian (except for filming participants) from proceeding over those lengths of highway in the borough of Lancaster as shown in the schedule below;

Marine Road East	From its Junction with Broadway to its Junction with Lord Street	Will be operative from 0600 to 1200 on 28 <sup>th</sup> May 2026
Marine Road East	From its Junction with Lord Street and Northumberland Street	Will be operative from 1200 to 1800 on 28 <sup>th</sup> May 2026
Skipton Street, Back Crescent Street, Graham Street, Derby Street, Tunstall Street & Anderton Street	For their entire length	Will be operative from 1800 to 2000 on 28 <sup>th</sup> May 2026

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed and Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

The temporary prohibitions are necessary to enable the filming of the television series "The Bay".

The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Diversions will be signed locally

A HGV Diversion for traffic from Marine Drive East will follow; Lord Street – Euston Road – Central Drive – Marine Road West and Vice Versa.
