(BARLEY NEW ROAD AND THE AVENUE, BARLEY, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - i. **Barley New Road, Barley** from its junction with The Avenue for approximately 233 metres in a easterly direction.
 - ii. **The Avenue, Barley** from its junction with Barley New Road to its junction with Barley Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours until 1530 on Wednesday 1st July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Barley Lane – Cross Lane – Newchurch – Spenbrook Road – Heights Lane – Noggarth Road – Ridge Lane – Barley New Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation clearance around overhead electrical cables to be carried out.
