

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BOOTH ROAD, STACKSTEADS, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Booth Road, Stacksteads, Rossendale from its junction with Fearn Moss to its junction with Bankfield Street.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1210 hours on Tuesday 19th May 2026 until 2359 hours on or Thursday 21st May 2026 until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified. Access for emergency services will be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent pre surface dressing works, works to be carried out by LCC
