

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(WILLOWS LANE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER**  
**202\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Willows Lane, Accrington, the north east side, from a point 26 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Broadfield Road for a distance of 14 metres in a south easterly direction;
- b) Willows Lane, Accrington, the south west side, from a point 11.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Broadfield Road for a distance of 53 metres in a south easterly direction.
