GARSTANG ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Garstang Road, Preston from its junction with Eastway to its junction with Sharrow Green Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily from 0900 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 26th May 2026 until Tuesday 9th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing works to be carried out.
