

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GOOSNARGH LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER
2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 22nd May 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Goosnargh Lane, Preston, the north and north east side, from a point 14 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Willow Grove for a distance of 95 metres in a north westerly direction;
- b) Goosnargh Lane, Preston, the south and south west side, from a point 14 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Willow Grove for a distance of 100 metres in a north westerly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 8th June 2026. A copy of the Order, and all other relevant documents may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Preston City Council, PO Box 10, Town Hall, Lancaster Road, Preston, PR1 2RL, and at the offices of The Director of Law and Governance, Lancashire County Council, County Hall, PO Box 100, Preston PR1 0LD, and on Lancashire County Councils Website <http://www.lancashire.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/roads/roadworks-and-traffic-regulation-orders/permanent.aspx>, quoting ref:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
