The above Order, made on 29 November 2023, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by recording restricted byway from a point at the junction of Lee Lane (U5295) and Old Lane (U458) in a south easterly direction along the southern edge of the garden of Blackleage Cottage to pass through a boundary and a junction with Footpath Bispham 3 and continuing in a generally south easterly direction within a sunken and largely overgrown strip of land shared with an unnamed watercourse through to the point where the watercourse is culverted and the route continues for a short distance along an enclosed track south of Bentley Lodge to exit onto Bentley Lane; a total distance of 375 metres.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FACTORY LANE, PENWORTHAM, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Factory Lane, Penwortham from 20 metres either side of the level crossing.
- Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Sunday 14th January 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:
