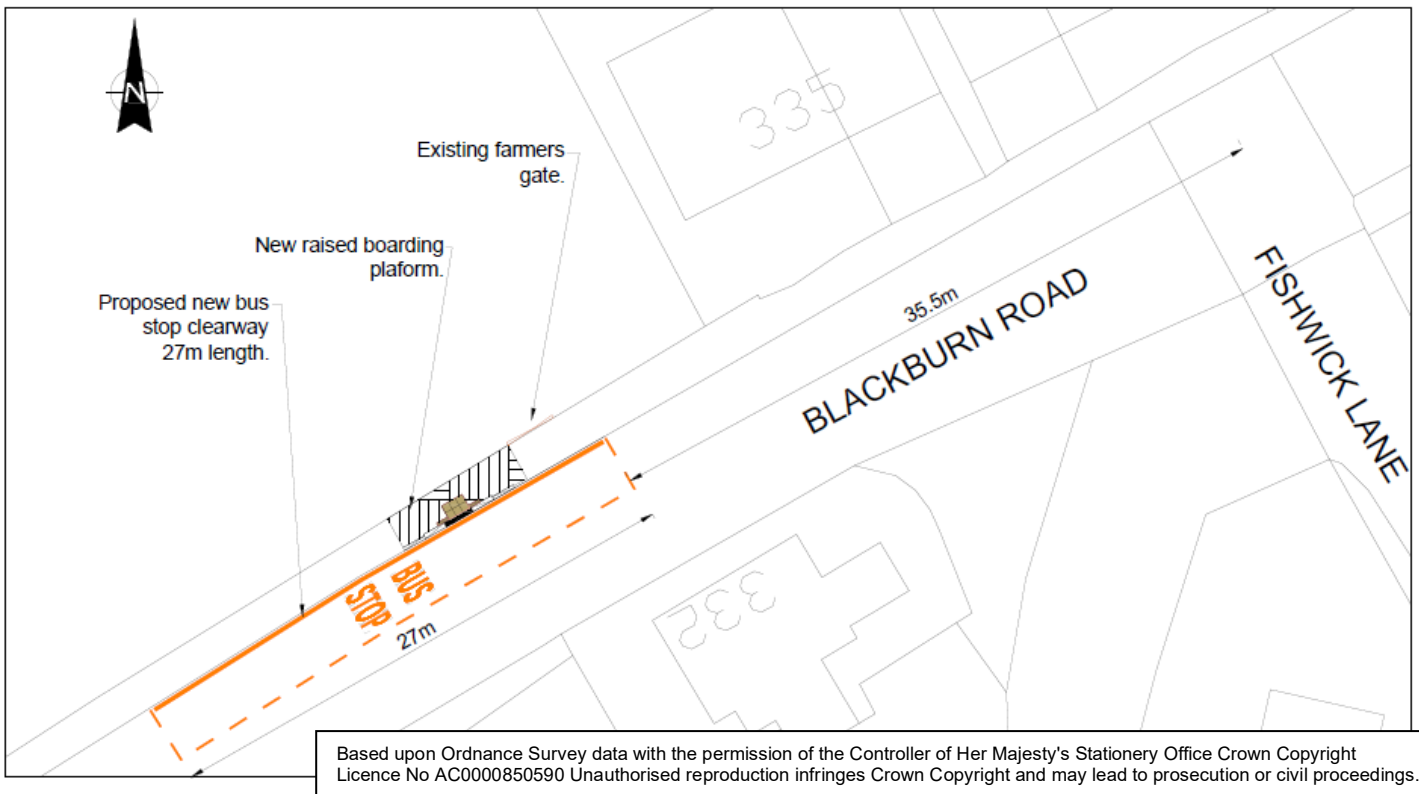


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BLACKBURN ROAD, HIGHER WHEELTON, CHORLEY
BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAY (NO1))

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to introduce the above Bus Stop Clearway. Following consultation carried out between 3rd March 2026 and 31st March 2026, it is now intended to modify the proposal as titled above, as set out below.

1. Remove the previously proposed bus stop clearway in Blackburn Road, Higher Wheelton, the north west side, from a point 24.2 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Fishwick Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a south westerly direction.
2. Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Blackburn Road, Higher Wheelton, the north west side, from a point 35.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Fishwick Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop to a quality bus stop clearway. This is to allow the buses to pull in and out safely and allow effective enforcement. A raised boarding platform will also be installed to ensure safe boarding and alighting of passengers.

Having considered objections and feedback from residents on Blackburn Road, Higher Wheelton, it is proposed to amend the original proposal. This adjustment is needed so we can move the bus stop clearway further south west of its location so we can preserve resident parking in the vicinity.
