LIGHTFOOT LANE, FULWOOD, PRESTON CITY  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lightfoot Lane, Fulwood from its junction with The Maples to the side of number 115 Lightfoot Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 1800 hours on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Lightfoot Lane – Tom Benson Way – Tag Lane – Woodplumpton Road – Cadley Causeway – Black Bull Lane – Garstang Road – Eastway – Lightfoot Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow joint cabling works to be carried out.
