

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(PADIHAM ROAD, SABDEN, RIBBLE VALLEY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Padiham Road, Sabden from its junction with Simonstone Road travelling in an easterly direction to a point adjacent to Chew Barn Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 08:00 hours until 16:00 hours on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2026 until 22<sup>nd</sup> July hours or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Simonstone Road – Trapp Lane – School Lane – Whalley Road – Barrowford Road – Slade Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of British Telecom to carry out essential works on their assets.
