(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Albert Road, Morecambe at its Junction with Claremont Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 19:00 hours on Thursday 4th June 2026 until 04:00 hours on Friday 5th June or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Clarendon Road East – Regent Road – Marine Road West

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Sapphire Utilities to install a Flow Monitor in a chamber on behalf of United Utilities.
