

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BELVEDERE ROAD, BRUNSHAW ROAD, HARRY POTTS WAY, HIGGIN STREET,
TODMORDEN ROAD AND YORKSHIRE STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 202*

The County Council of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and 92 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Definitions and Interpretation

For all the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:

- a) **"Burnley Football Club Duly Authorised Person"** is defined as a named member of Burnley Football Club that has been given specific responsibility for the management of the Public during a Football Match at Turf Moor Football Ground as agreed prior in writing with The Council's Duly Authorised Officer.
- b) **"The Council's Duly Authorised Officer"** means a person appointed by the council or its local agent or authority to administer the powers conferred on the said Council by the Act with respect to this and other Traffic Regulations.
- c) **"Football Match"** is defined as a game of football, involving the first team of Burnley Football Club at Turf Moor Football Ground in Burnley.
- d) **"Match Day"** means the day in which a Football Match is held at Turf Moor football ground in Burnley.
- e) **"Pedal Cycle"** means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle, or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Act;
- f) **"Vehicle"** means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motorcycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power;

2. Revocation

The "Lancashire County Council (Harry Potts Way, Belvedere Road, Yorkshire Street And Todmorden Road Burnley, Burnley Borough) (Prohibition Of Driving) Order 2012" is hereby revoked in full.

3. Prohibition of Driving

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Burnley Football Club Duly Authorised Person, cause or permit any Vehicle or Pedal Cycle, to proceed along the roads specified in the vicinity of Turf Moor football ground on Match Days, as described in the Schedules to this Order. The prohibition will be enforced by the way of moveable barriers.

This prohibition includes provision for an obstruction to be placed in accordance with Section 92 of the Act

4. Miscellaneous

The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

5. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the ***** 202* and may be cited as the “Lancashire County Council (Belvedere Road, Brunshaw Road, Harry Potts Way, Higgin Street, Todmorden Road And Yorkshire Street, Burnley, Burnley Borough) (Prohibition Of Driving) Order 202*”.

Schedule 1 – Prohibition of Driving on match days (from 2 hours before the start of the match until 1 hour after the end of the match, not to exceed 8 hours within a 24 hour period) when determined to be required (decision to be made by the Burnley Football Club Duly Authorised Person, on or before match day)

- a) Belvedere Road, Burnley, from its junction with Yorkshire Street/Harry Potts Way to its junction with Ormerod Road.
- b) Brunshaw Road, Burnley, from its junction with Harry Potts Way to its junction with Mitella Street.
- c) Harry Potts Way, Burnley, for the entire length.
- d) Higgin Street, Burnley, from its junction with Harry Potts Way/Brunshaw Road to its junction with Prescott Street.

Schedule 2 – Prohibition of Driving on match days (from 2 hours before the start of the match until 1 hour after the end of the match, not to exceed 8 hours within a 24 hour period) when determined to be required (decision to be made by the Burnley Football Club Duly Authorised Person, on or before match day, depending on specific circumstances and the category of the match)

- a) Todmorden Road, Burnley, from its junction with Yorkshire Street/Harry Potts Way to its junction with Lyndhurst Road.
- b) Yorkshire Street, Burnley, from its junction with Harry Potts way to its junction with Church Street/Centenary Way.

Please note: The Prohibition of Driving restriction may not last the full length of time stated above, to be determined by the Burnley Football Club Duly Authorised Person, as appropriate.
