THE DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE COUNTY OF LANCASHIRE

THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC FOOTPATH FROM UNION ROAD TO RAWTENSTALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH 321, DEARDEN HEIGHTS, ROSSENDALE (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) ORDER 2014

The above Order, made on the 22nd October 2014, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by adding a public footpath Union Road, Rawtenstall (Point A on the Order map) to Public Footpath 321, Rawtenstall (Point B), for a total length of approximately 200m.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be seen free of charge at the offices of the Rossendale Borough Council, and at my offices from 9am to 5pm on weekdays. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.00.

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to The County Secretary and Solicitor, Lancashire County Council, PO Box 78, County Hall, Preston, PR1 8XJ (REF: LSG4/PROW/5.49860/MB) not later than 14th January 2015, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, Lancashire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
