(TREALES ROAD, TREALES ROSEACRE AND WHARLES, FYLDE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Treales Road, Treales Roseacre and Wharles from its junction with Jacobs Lane for 100 metres in a Westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 09:30 hours until 15:30 hours on Wednesday 17th July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Church Road – Inskip Road – Salwick Road – Dagger Road – Vice
Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals.
