

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(BRYNING HALL LANE, BRYNING WITH WARTON, FYLDE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bryning Hall Lane, Bryning with Warton from its junction with Corka Lane to Bryning Hall Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:30 hours on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 16:30 hours on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Bryning Lane, Moss Side Lane, Corka Lane – Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole maintenance works to be carried out.
