

Supplementary statement to Lancashire Health and Wellbeing Board's Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment

Date Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment published – October 2025

The Regulations state that supplementary statements can provide updates to the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) only in relation to changes in the availability of pharmaceutical services. Supplementary Statements cannot provide updates on pharmaceutical need. This can only be achieved through a review of the PNA. The following pharmaceutical services currently contained within the PNA have been identified as needing updating. This updated information supersedes some of the original information within the PNA and should be read in conjunction with that document.
