(AUGHTON ROAD, GRESSINGHAM, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Aughton Road, Gressingham from the Junction of Lea Lane for Approximately 50 metres in a southerly Direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Wednesday 17th June 2026 until 1700 hours on Thursday 25th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Aughton Road - Borwick Road - Kirkby Lonsdale Road - Aughton Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to Excavate joint bay with track in the verge and carriageway to install and joint cable for New Hv mains to new substation to be carried out.
