(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of St Crispin Way, Haslingden from its junction with Grane Road to its junction with Flip Road.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2000 hours on Thursday 11th June 2026 until 0600 hours on Saturday 13th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent removal of diseased tree to stop then falling into the carriageway works to be carried out by National Highways.
