

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(GAGE STREET, MARY STREET, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over the following lengths of roads;
  - I. Gage Street, Lancaster from its junction with Mary Street for a distance of approximately 30 metres in an Easterly Direction.
  - II. Mary Street, Lancaster from its junction Gage Street for a distance of approximately 15 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0755 hours on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2026 until 2359 hours on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary due to a dangerous Building.
