The above Order, made on the 12<sup>th</sup> November 2025, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by deleting part of Footpath FP0325049 from its junction with Whitecroft Lane running generally south-west then south through the building and garden of the property known as Whitecroft Barn to the boundary with a pasture, and adding a footpath from a junction with Whitecroft Lane running south along the driveway of Whitecroft Barn then south-west through the former farmyard and the unmarked edge of that farmyard to the boundary between the garden and the pasture.

The length of the route to be added is 50m and varies in width between 2 metres and 5.5 metres.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Notice is hereby given that Lancaster City Council, with the consent of Lancashire County Council and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police, and in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33, 34 35, 35 (c), 39, 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has made the above-named Order.

The effect of the Amendment No. 3 Order of 2025 is to (1) add a new car park to be known as Moor Mills 4, Lancaster associated plan (plan 36), conditions of use, charges and permit arrangements (2) add a new car park to be known as Edward Street 2, Lancaster associated plan (plan 37), conditions of use, charges and permit arrangements (3) amend plan 23 (Kingsway, Lancaster) to extend the car park area (5) Amend plan 17 Old Station Morecambe and create a 40 minutes 3 hour no return loading bay restriction highlighted in the blue box on Plan 17. (6) Add a 2hrs for £3.30 tariff between 8am & 6pm to the First Schedule – Table 1 to the car parks detailed in the second table below (7) Amend Article 4(1), (3), (4) substituting the reference to “the seventh column” to read “the eighth column”.

On the 05 November 2025 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by adding a Footpath from a point on Slyne Road A6, between 59 and 57 Slyne Road (former Melbourne Social Club) at grid reference SD 4767 6331 to pathway leading south to exit onto Vale Road at grid reference SD 4763 6330.

#### LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PETER LANE, COACH ROAD, YEALAND CONYERS, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads;
  - Coach Road, Yealand Conyers from its junction with Main Street to its junction with Peter Lane.
  - Peter Lane, Yealand Conyers from its junction with Coach Road to a point outside property known as Manor House Farm.
