(CARR END LANE, STALMINE-WITH-STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Carr End Lane, Stalmine-With-Staynall from its junction with Clover Lane for 10 metres in either direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Monday 13th July 2026 until Friday 31st July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Carr End Lane – Smithy Lane – Mill Lane – Stricklands Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow junction improvements including the creation of a new footpath in both directions outside of a new Wainhomes site as part of a S278 application to be carried out by JJ O'Grady Limited.
