
(BACK HEWTHWAITE TERRACE, CARNFORTH, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Back Hewthwaite Terrace, Carnforth at a point outside rear of 138 Lancaster Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 22nd June 2024 until 1600 hours on Wednesday 24th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. . Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Lancaster Road - Queen Street - Lancaster Road - Albert Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow medium sided disconnection of old lead supply and replace with a new connection to the 4" main to be carried out.
