

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PADIHAM ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor to proceed over that length of Padiham Road, Burnley from its junction with Stephenson Drive to its junction with Cavarly Way.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0600 hours until 1800 on Monday 22nd June 2026 until Friday 26th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent carriageway surface dressing treatment works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
