

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(BLACKBURN ROAD, EDENFIELD, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blackburn Road, Edenfield from its junction with Burnley Road to its junction with Esk Avenue.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2026 until 2359 hours on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
  
Burnley Road – Bury Road – Haslingden Road - Manchester Road  
Blackburn Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow reinstatement of previous works and to repair the appropriate defects works to be carried out by Vocon Ltd on behalf of Quinn Civil Engineering.
