

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(SPRING LANE, HASLINGDEN, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Spring Lane, Haslingden from its junction with Blackburn Road to its junction with Lower Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 1800 hours on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- Blackburn Road- Regent Street- Church Street, Lower Lane-Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the re- excavation of a joint bay in the carriageway and to install and joint cable, works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity Northwest.
