

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SANDYGATE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sandygate, Burnley from its junction with Trafalgar Street to its junction with Neptune Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20th July 2026 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 22nd July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Sandygate- Queens Lancashire Way- Manchester Road- Trafalgar Street -Vice
Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the removal of an existing granite speed bump and replacing it with a tarmac speed hump. Works to be carried out by Barnfield Construction Limited.
