**BOROUGH) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 18th June 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Speed Limit Order under Section 84 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in the following lengths of road:

- a) Collingwood Avenue, Barton, Preston, the entire length;
- b) Fairlie Drive, Barton, Preston, the entire length;
- c) Palmerston Road, Barton, Preston, the entire length.

This Order will come into force on the 29th June 2026.
