(F4251 FOXFOLD, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of F4251 Foxfold, Skelmersdale from its junction with U610 Foxfold, Skelmersdale for an approximate distance of 20m in a Northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1415 hours on Monday 29th June 2026 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 1st July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent low voltage cable fault repair works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
