

## **LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**MARKET STREET AND CHEAPSIDE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
  - i) Cheapside, from its junction with Market Street to its junction with Fishergate.
  - ii) Market Street, from its junction with Cheapside to its junction with Earl Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition in article 1 (i) will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 0800 hours on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. The prohibition in article 1 (ii) will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
6. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Glovers Court – Sykes Street – Avenham Lane – Queens Street – Lord Road – Ring Way – Tithebarn Street – Lord Street – Lancaster Road – Harris Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new footway, carriageway and cycle lane construction works to be carried out.
