(ALDRENS LANE & SKERTON ROAD, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Aldrens Lane & Skerton Road, Lancaster from Owen Road to the Electricity Substation on Owen Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 hours to 1500 hours on Tuesday 7th July 2026 to Thursday 16th July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Owen Road – Slyne Road – Whalley Road – Green Lane – Halton Road – Main Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council
