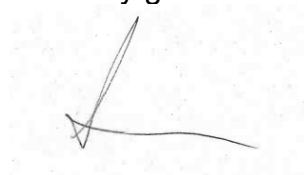
(TAYLORS MEANYGATE, TARLETON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Taylors Meanygate, Tarleton from its junction with Boundary Meanygate, for a distance of 220 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 to 1530 hours on Thursday 24th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever at all times.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Moss Lane, Hesketh Lane, Church Road, Gorse Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of overhead cable works to be carried out.
