(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Durton Lane, Broughton from either side of the M6 bridge, from its junction with Broddick Close to outside of Adamson House Farm.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative for nightly works from 2000 hours until 0500 hours on Monday 20th July 2026 until Saturday 25th July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent underbridge concrete works to be carried out.
