(CLOUGH END ROAD, HASLINGDEN, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council had ,has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Clough End Road, Haslingden from its junction with Clough End Road to its junction with Kings Highway.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0700 hours until 1700 on Friday 4th September 2026 until Tuesday 15th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Brook Street, Hud Hey Road- Rising Bridge Road- Blackburn Road- Northfield Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation of a joint bay to install a new connection point for a car charging point works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity Northwest.
