BOYS LANE, FULWOOD, PRESTON CITY

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cyclists or pedestrians to proceed over that length of Boys Lane, Fulwood from outside of Holly Bank to outside of Ingol Head Cottages.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Thursday 29th October 2026 until Friday 30th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Emergency access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Boys Lane – Black Bull Lane – Cadley Causeway – Woodplumpton Road – Tag Lane – Tom Benson Way – Lightfoot Lane – Wychnor – Walker Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow essential tree maintenance works to be carried out.
