

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(NEWTON ROAD AND BACK LANE, NEWTON, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Newton Road and Back Lane, Newton as follows: -
  - **Newton Road** - in its entirety
  - **Back Lane** - from its junction with Slaidburn Road to its junction with Hallgate Hill.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 06:00 hours until 18:00 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 17<sup>th</sup> August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

**Newton Road** - Hallgate Hill - Slaidburn Road - West Bradford Road - Clitheroe Road - West Bradford Road - Pimlico Link Road - Chatburn Road - Well Terrace - Railway View Road - Station Road - Parson Lane - Edisford Road - Clitheroe Road - Whitewell Road - Dunsop Road

**Back Lane** - Slaidburn Road - Hallgate Hill

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out surface dressing works.
