(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of A59 Liverpool Road South, Burscough from its junction with Trevor Road to its junction with Chancel Way.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 2000 to 0500 hours on Monday 5th October until Friday 9th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
A59 Liverpool Road South, A59 High Lane, A59 County Road, A570 Southport Road, A570 Scarisbrick New Road, A570 Eastbank Street, A565 Lord Street, A565 Albert Road, A565 Park Crescent, A565 Cambridge Road, A565 Preston New Road, A565 Water Lane, A565 Southport New Road, A59 Liverpool Road, A59 Causeway Lane, A59 Moss Lane, A59 Liverpool Road North and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.
