(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Moor Lane, Castle Gate and Parson Lane, Clitheroe in their entirety.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 06:00 hours until 18:00 hours on 19th July 2026 until 16th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Whalley Road – Whalley Clitheroe Bypass – Longsight Road - Ribchester Road
- Lower Road - Clitheroe Road - Longridge Road - Whalley Road - Clitheroe
Road – New Lane - Edisford Road - Bawdlands

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out carriageway surface dressing works.
