INGLEWHITE ROAD, SILK MILL LANE, CARRON LANE AND BUTTON STREET,
INGLEWHITE, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway laid out in the road closures schedule of this order.
2. The prohibitions will be operative on the dates specified in the dates of operation column of the schedule to this order. Any individual prohibitions or restrictions may be removed before their stated end time if deemed safe and appropriate.

Road Name	Length Affected	Dates of Operation
Silk Mill Lane	From its junction with Langley Lane to its junction with Inglewhite Road	0730 – 0900 hours on Tuesday 17 th November 2026
Button Street	From its junction with Carron Lane to its junction with Fairhurst Lane	0900 – 1030 hours on Tuesday 17 th November 2026
Inglewhite Road	From its junction with Langley Lane to its junction with Silk Mill Lane	1030 – 1200 hours on Tuesday 17 th November 2026
Carron Lane	From its junction with Silk Mill Lane to outside of Bourne Brow	1300 – 1430 hours on Tuesday 17 th November 2026

3. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow litter and fly tip removal works to be carried out.
