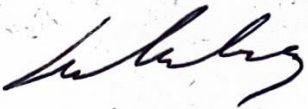
(SALTOAK ROAD, PRESTON LANCASTER ROAD, BAY HORSE, LANCASTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No.2) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads;
 - I. Saltoak Road, Bay Horse from its junction with Hollins Lane, to its junction with Preston Lancaster Road.
 - II. Preston Lancaster Road, Bay Horse from its junction with Saltoak Road to its junction with Bay Horse Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5th October 2026 until 1600 hours on Friday 9th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Preston Lancaster Road – A6 Lancaster Road – A6 Main Road – Salt Oak Road and Nive Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to facilitate new fibre broadband connections.
