(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

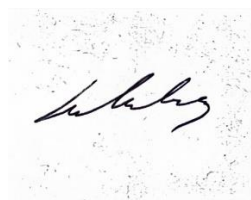
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Trough Road, Dunsop Bridge from a point adjacent to Sykes Cottage to its entrance with Langden House.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 09:30 hours until 15:00 hours on 12th October 2026 and 13th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Dunsop Road - Chipping Road - Green Lane - Talbot Street - Garstang Road - Collins Hill - Fiddlers Lane - Lower Core Lane - Oakencloough Road - Bleasdale Lane - Delph Lane - Long Lane - Scorton Marshaw Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of British Telecom to carry out pole replacement works.
