(ESHTON TERRACE, CLITHEROE, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Eshton Terrace, Clitheroe from a point at the level crossing travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 00:01 hours until 08:30 hours on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
  - **Easterly** – Woone Lane – Moor Lane – Parsons Lane – Badlands – Thorn Street
  - **Westerly** – Thorn Street – Badlands – Station Road – King Street – Market Place – Wellgate – Lowergate – Whalley Road – Greenacre Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail to carry essential inspections on the level crossing.
