(GREENS LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Greens Lane, DownHolland from outside property number 11 for a distance of 400 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 1st September until 1700 hours on Monday 7th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Eager Lane, Hall Lane, Pygons Hill Lane, Moss Lane, A59 Northway, Turnpike Road, B5195 Formby Lane, B5195 Birches Brow, B5195 Broad Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation for electricity works to be carried out.
