(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC AND LEFT/RIGHT
TURNS) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Scale Hall Lane, Lancaster from its junction with Morecambe Road for approximately 5 metres in a North Eastley direction
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Friday 4th September 2026 until 1700 hours on Saturday 5th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Civils work across Scale Hall Lane with junction work to refurbish the traffic signals works to be carried out Lancashire County Council.
