MILL LANE AND BROADITH LANE, GOOSNARGH, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Mill Lane and Broadith Lane, Goosnargh from its junction with Curwen Lane to approximately 1300 metres in a southerly direction near its junction with Church Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 24th August 2026 until Tuesday 25th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Inglewhite Road – Derby Road – Preston Road – Whittingham Road – Cumeragh Lane – Whittingham Lane – Church Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
