(B5272 GARSTANG ROAD, COCKERHAM, LANCASTRE CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of B5272 Garstang Road, Cockerham from its junction with Cockerham Road to its junction with B5272 Park Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 29th September 2026 until 2300 hours on Thursday 1st October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Ratcliffe Wharf Lane – A6 Lancaster Road – Cockerham Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow chamber-rebuild works to be carried out.
