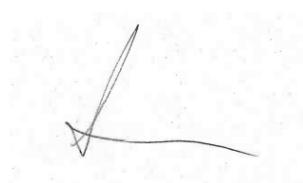
(MOSS DELPH LANE, AUGHTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Moss Delph Lane, Aughton from its junction with the B5197 Prescott Road for a distance of 100 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 to 1700 hours on Saturday 5th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
B5197 Prescott Road, Long Lane, A59 Liverpool Road, A59 Northway, Moss Delph Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works on old lead supply to be carried out.
