(HOLLINS LANE AND HOLLINS CLOSE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over those lengths of
 - i. **Hollins Lane, Accrington** from outside property named The Bungalow to outside 48 Hollins Lane.
 - ii. **Hollins Close, Accrington** from its junction with Hollins Lane to outside 1 Hollins Close
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1100 hours on Sunday 2nd August 2026 until 2359 hours on Thursday 6th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the urgent repair to low voltage fault in the carriageway to be carried out Electricity Nort West.
