(REAR OF 31 BERRY STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY, BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Berry Road, Burnley from outside the rear of property number 31 for 10 meters in either direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1135 hours on Tuesday 11th August 2026 until 2359 hours on Friday 14th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavation of the carriageway to repair a leaking stop tap works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
