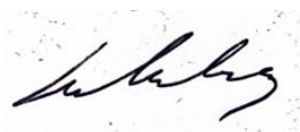
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stirling Court, Briercliffe from its junction with Halifax Road, Briercliffe to outside property number 1.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 12th October 2026 until 1800 hours on Friday 27th November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained wherever and whenever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
No Diversion route possible, due to being a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow major gas main replacement works, works to be carried out by Cadent.
