(KIRKBY LONSDALE ROAD, ARKHOLME, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle and pedestrian to proceed over that length of Kirkby Lonsdale Road, Arkholme from outside Arkholme Methodist Church for approximately 175 metres in a south westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Monday 24th August 2026 until 0000 hours on Friday 18th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. Emergency vehicle will need to follow diversion.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
 Docke Lane – Lancaster Brow – Keer Holme Lane – Borwick Road
 and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the reconstruction of damaged retaining wall to be carried out Lancashire County Council.
